We manage an environmentally aware sustainable tourism business on a family run High Nature Value farm here at Treshnish, on the Isle of Mull.

We have been members of Green Tourism Business Scheme since 1997, and have held a Gold Award since 2001.

This means:

- We comply with the relevant environmental legislation as a minimum level of performance.
- We have a strong commitment to continuous improvement.
- We are committed to raising awareness of green issues with everyone we work with, both on the farm and in the cottages.
- We review our performance regularly and are audited by GTBS every 2 years.
- We monitor energy usage and energy generation, striving towards being 'energy neutral'.
- We work to reduce our carbon emissions and other greenhouse gases.
- We are careful to minimize use of hazardous and toxic substances.
- We promote the use of public transport.
- We are involved locally with community projects. We are members/supporters of Dervaig Community Woodland; Mull and Iona Community Trust; Friends of Calgary Bay; a local pressure group, No Neonicotinoids on Mull; Mull and Iona Food Trail.
- We are continuing to improve our energy efficiency and water usage. (LEDs in office/laundry, West, Middle and East; improved insulation in West and East)
- We use natural and environmentally friendly products and services, as routine.
- We strive to minimise waste. (Bulk ordering, reusing, recycling).
- We source Fairtrade, ethical products and services wherever we can.
